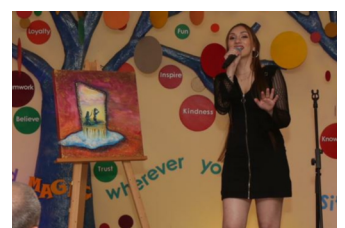
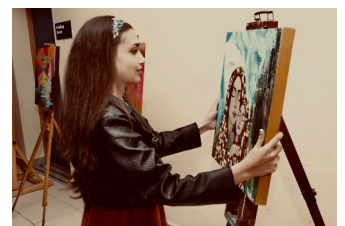
MESSAĠĠ MILL-KAP TAL-ISKOLA

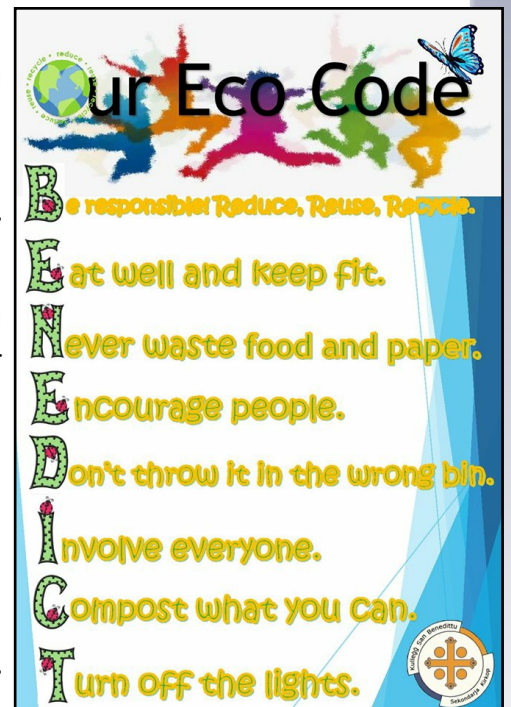
batteriji li kien fihom u tpoġġew f'postijiet li jistgħu jintlaħqu aħjar.

MALTA MATHEMATICS OLYMPIAD 2019

Bejn Novembru 2018 u April 2019, erba' studenti mill-iskola tagħna attendew għal numru ta' sessjonijiet ta' taħriġ waqt il-brejk it-twil tagħhom. Matulhom, Liam Vella (tal-10 sena), Kylie Sciberras (tal-10 sena), Marcette Polidano (tad-9 sena) u Julia Portelli (tad-9 sena) kienu jaħdmu problemi matematiċi avvanzati biex jippreparaw



ruħhom għall-Maths Olympiad. Dan l-avveniment isir kull sentejn u fih ilaqqa' studenti mill-iskejjel kollha ta' Malta u Għawdex, li huma l-aktar kompetenti fil-Matematika. Il-kompetizzjoni tikkonsisti fi tliet sessjonijiet ta' 45 minuta u l-istudenti jridu jwieġbu bil-miktub il-mistoqsijiet li jingħatawllhom. Huma jikkompetu bejniethom, kemm fuq bażi individwali kif ukoll fuq bażi ta' skola. Permezz tal-istudenti tagħna, l-iskola rnexxielha takkwista l-11-il post mill-31 skola parteċipanti u t-tieni post mill-iskejjel kollha tal-gvern. Prosit lil dawn l-istudenti u nawgurawllhom ikomplu jieħdu interess fil-Matematika.

Din is-sena id-dipartiment innota wkoll li fl-iskola tagħna għandna 2 studenti li huma tajbin ħafna biex isolvu r-Rubik Cube billi jirnexxilhom, f'ħin qasir ħafna, jagħmlu kull faċċata tal-kubu bl-istess kulur. Għalhekk, l-iskola ħasbet biex tressaq dawn l-istudenti għall-Malta Records ukoll. L-aqwa ħin li l-istudent Erik Canova (tat-3 sena) rnexxielu jikseb quddiem il-ġudikant tal-

Malta Records kien ta' 47.04 sekonda, filwaqt li l-aqwa ħin tal-istudent Juan Scerri (tal-5 sena) irnexxielu jikseb ħin impressjonanti ta' 19.45 sekonda. Għalhekk Juan Scerri naqqax ismu u dak tal-iskola bħala l-persuna f'Malta li solviet ir-Rubik Cube fl-iqsar ħin. Prosit tassew lil Eric u lil Juan!

A MATHEMATICS LESSON STUDY

The concept of a lesson study originated in Japan in order to encourage teachers to learn from each other and to develop professionally together. Through a lesson study teachers collaborate to create a high quality lesson based on their collective experiences while learning from each other in the process.

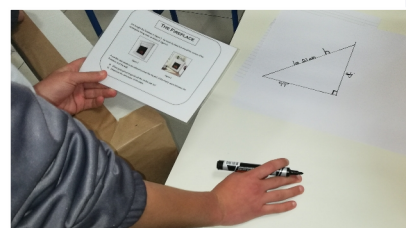
At our school, Ms L. Vella, Ms L. Libreri, Ms R. Galea, Ms M. Saliba and Mr A. Ellul decided to embark on a mathematics lesson study for the first time. Throughout this scholastic year we held weekly meetings to be able to plan and prepare the lesson. During one of the initial meetings, Mr James Calleja was invited to share his experience in this area and to help the group gain a better insight on how to proceed throughout this exercise. The group then discussed the main objectives of the lesson. Our main objective was to encourage students to apply the mathematical concepts learnt in class to a real-life situation and to make connections between different topics. A situation was created: *A worker needs to position a fireplace in the corner of a rectangular room in a symmetrical manner. What are the dimensions of the marble slab which is needed to cover the empty space between the fireplace and the wall?*

After finalising the wording of the question, to make the situation more realistic, we decided to build six life-size fireplaces out of cardboard and paper – one fireplace for each group. A 4-minute play was also written, enacted and video-recorded. This was to be used as an introduction to the lesson to help the students familiarise themselves with the situation. More discussions were held to finetune the lesson procedure and provide other resources that were needed.

One of the teachers conducted the first trial of the lesson. A University lecturer and another Maths teacher were invited to attend. They, together with the other teachers of the group, observed both the

lesson and the way particular students dealt with the task at hand. After the lesson, feedback was collected from all the observers and discussed. We then made the necessary changes to the lesson plan and another teacher then conducted the same lesson with another class of the same Year and track. For the second trial, besides the teachers of the group, an Education Officer was invited to observe the lesson and to provide feedback. The lesson plan was then finalised after another round of evaluation was carried out.

One of the observations that surprised us was the fact that the students who do not usually perform very well in class, when given a real-life situation, can contribute a lot to the group. Strangely, the traditionally good performers needed more help to be able to handle such real-life situations.



Looking back, the lesson study provided us with a number of challenges. What topics shall we tackle? What situation/task shall we create? Are we going to have enough time to come up with all the resources we plan? If it had just been one teacher planning the lesson, it would have been nearly impossible to deliver since so much preparation time was required! Throughout the whole exercise we continuously shared problems and offered solutions; we supported each other and this could not have been possible if it were not for our great sense of collegiality.



Some students in our schools are involved in the eTwinning project "Educate" assisted by Ms Rodianne Haber. eTwinning is a European platform that gives the opportunity to teachers and students from different countries to engage in projects to collaborate, share and communicate with each other online.

Last March, Ms Erica Cezek (Assistant Head), had the opportunity to attend an eTwinning seminar in Pogradec, Albania, on how to find collaborative ways through eTwinning for new initiatives with regards to 'Problem Solving and Critical Thinking in our Schools'. The aim of such seminars is for educators from all over Europe to meet, collaborate and get involved in projects together for the benefit of their students. During this seminar, participants worked and discussed changing and improving their methodology based upon the mentioned concepts. Teachers shared ideas, experiences and good practices and a common factor highlighted was that their students engage most effectively during project-based learning. It empowers them

to control their learning and it teaches higher order knowledgeable skills such as producing new and innovative ideas and solving problems, reflecting critically on learning experiences and making effective decisions. They participated in workshops focused on teaching and eliciting vital employability skills, by giving students the opportunity to work in teams, communicate, share and learn from and contribute to the learning of others.

In April, Mr Jurgen Azzopardi attended another eTwinning seminar in Izmir, Turkey for teachers who are new to the platform. The eTwinning platform was introduced and made clear the various values this programme can instil in students and teachers. It is an easy practice that can be seamlessly integrated in the daily school life of teachers and students but that will considerably strengthen the learning experiences of anyone involved. Multiple good practices of projects and their positive outcomes were presented. One could easily learn how good planning can easily achieve great results. During this seminar, participants had the opportunity to mingle and make contacts for future projects.



Our school is looking forward to begin working on other new projects and would like to encourage anyone to get on board this platform for the benefit of our students, our school community and for the professional growth and development of the staff.

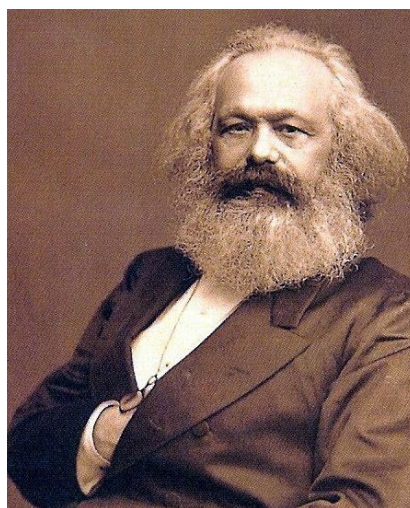

His mother and father were Dutch, and he was Jewish. This man's works have effected the times to come; have effected how philosophers think and society. Karl Marx's most popular works, are Das Kapital and the Communist Manifesto. Karl believed in socialist ideals with collaboration to Friedrich Engels they spread the global ideology.

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Marx was known to be against a capitalist industry where the owners manipulate capital goods and distribute pay if any to the workers. The income is led to the owners for profit rather than to the workers and the nation. The works of Karl and Engels have raised the will of the people to fight against inequality, but also created countries like the Soviet Union. In no way he wanted to create harsh dictatorships like Joseph Stalin did. In his mind he wanted a society which equally distributes goods to the state and industry is owned by the state rather than by the owners. His work still affects our thinking and his work is still being followed till this day.

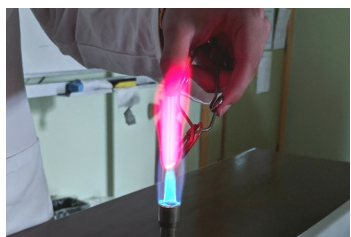
