Kull student hu obbligat bil-liġi li jattendi l-iskola sa minn età bikrija. Kull student hu obbligat bil-liġi li jibqa' jattendi sal-età ta' 16-il sena. L-istudenti huma obbligati jsegwu kurrikulu preskritt tul dawn l-ghaxar snin. Kurrikulu maħsub biex jagħti l-istess opportunità lil kulħadd.

Madankollu r-riżultati u r-riċerka juru li għalkemm l-istudenti għandhom l-istess opportunità jitgħallmu, mhux kollha jitgħallmu bl-istess mod. Minħabba f'hekk, numru kbir ta' studenti kien qed jitilfu l-interess fil-proċess edukattiv, ma jibqgħux jistudjaw u saħansitra jitilqu l-iskola kmieni.



L-istatistika turi li 70% biss tal-istudenti kien qed ikomplu jistudjaw fil-livell post sekondarju waqt li l-oħrajn kien qed jieq fu u jfittxu impieg.

Kien għalhekk li minn din is-sena ġiet introdotta s-sistema 'My Journey', sistema li toffri rotot differenti għal studenti li jitgħallmu b'metodi differenti bl-iskop li kull student jieħu pjaċir jitgħalle u li l-istudenti jkomplu jistudjaw wara li jagħlqu s-sittax-il sena. Din is-sistema taħseb mhux biss għat-tfal akkademici iżda wkoll għal dawk li jitgħallmu iż-jed b'mod applikat.

Minn din is-sena, l-iskola tagħna qed toffri 12-il suġġett vokazzjonali u 12 applikat. Kien hemm respons qawwi għal dawn is-suġġetti hekk kif 72% tal-istudenti fit-tielet sena għażlu suġġetti vokazzjonali jew applikati.

TEEN SCIENCE CAFÉ GIRLS FESTIVAL

Fis-6 ta' Novembru, grupp ta' tfajliet tal-Ħdax-il sena li bħalissa qed jistudjaw is-suġġetti tax-xjenza, kellhom l-opportunità li jattendu 'Teen Science Café Girls Festival' ġewwa x-Xara Lodge, ir-Rabat. Dan il-festival jifforma parti mill-programm Ewropew GENE (Global Education Network Europe) li qed jiġi implimentat ġewwa diversi pajjiżi Ewropej fosthom Malta. L-għan ta' dan il-festival hu li jinkoraġġixxi lit-tfajliet ikomplu jistudjaw suġġetti tax-xjenza f' livell terzjarju u jispirahom sabiex jagħżlu karriera relatata ma' dawk imsejħha suġġetti 'STEM' (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics). Dan għaliex fi studji li saru madwar ħafna pajjiżi Ewropej, inkluż Malta, instab li ħafna iktar irġiel jaħdmu fil-qasam xjentiku milli nisa, speċjalment



f'karrieri bħal inginerija, l-iżvilupp ta' programmi tal-komputer kif ukoll bħala xjentisti ġewwa laboratorji.

F'dan il-festival l-istudenti kellhom l-opportunità li jiltaqgħu ma' diversi nisa Maltin li jaħdmu f'oqsma xjentifiċċi differenti, fosthom fl-Awtorită tar-Riżorsi u l-Ambjent (ERA), il-Transport Malta, l-Universită ta' Malta, l-Microsoft u l-Lufthansa Technik. Dawn il-professjonisti qasmu mal-istudenti l-esperjenza



tagħhom, fost l-oħrajn, x'ħajjarhom jibdew jistudjaw suġġetti tax-xjenza, id-diffikultajiet u l-isfidi li Itaqgħu magħhom, kif ukoll il-kisbiet tagħhom. Barra minn hekk, l-istudenti kellhom iċ-ċans li jinteraqixxu mill-qrib ma' dawn l-istess professjonisti billi jistaqsuhom xi kurżitajiet jew jaqsmu magħhom xi dilemmi li kellhom. STEM THEMATIC DEBATE

On the 24th November, I participated in the first edition of the STEM Thematic Debate.

On the 10th December I received the top debater award. The

debate focused on pollution and its

implications on the health of communities of low socio-economic status. A student representative from 12 different schools participated in the debate.

The first round took the form of a round table debate, where each student was allocated 2

minutes to present their argument on their given statement. My argument focused on the health of



communities of lower socio-economic status, which tends to be more affected by exposure to environmental hazards than the health of the general population. All arguments had to focus on the current situation of the Maltese islands. In the second round, after hearing the other students' arguments, we were given the opportunity to counter-argue another panel member's statement. In this round we had to tackle the 3 main environmental hazards, namely air pollution, noise pollution and



extreme heat. In the third round, each student had 30 seconds to conclude their argument.

A panel of judges was present throughout the whole debate to monitor and evaluate the students' active participation.

This was a very interesting opportunity as I was able not only to further my knowledge of environmental issues, but also to express my opinions on the subject during the debate.

This is an annual competition whereby students compete with other students from secondary schools. This year the theme was aligned to UNESCO's International Year of the Periodic Table of Chemical Elements.

As a team we had three hours to work on Chemistry, Biology and Physics investigation tasks related to Elements. It was a challenge to concentrate and focus, and at the same time to manage the time well. However we rose to the occasion and made good use of team work since we were very well
